Dear Senator Umberg,

On behalf of the County Board of Supervisors, I write to support AB 1150 (Schultz). This bill is a critical piece of legislation needed to modernize the Customer Facility Charge (CFC). The alternative CFC was last adjusted in 2010 and does not keep up with the rising costs of construction, maintenance and renovations at airport rental car facilities across California.

The CFC is a critical funding source for airports looking to build modern, efficient, and sustainable rental car facilities. The current CFC is insufficient to meet the financing **needs for rental car facilities at California's airports. Increasing the statutory cap** on the CFC and indexing it to inflation would provide airports with a more sustainable revenue stream, allowing them to modernize vital infrastructure and support seamless transportation systems.

AB 1150 would significantly enhance our Sacramento International Airport's ability to fund critical projects that improve convenience and efficiency for travelers. Additionally, it would provide our airport with a more sustainable revenue source to meet the rising expenses of building, maintaining and renovating aging rental car facilities while bolstering our ability to effectively serve our region's growing passenger demand.
